



SAFETY CASE PROJECT MANAGER AND ENGINEERS

RSRL is a leader in the field of nuclear decommissioning and manages the Harwell and Winfrith site restoration programmes under contract to the Nuclear Decommissioning Authority. The programmes encompass the recovery, treatment, packaging and storage of all forms of legacy waste. In parallel, progress will continue to be made on decommissioning, care and maintenance of facilities and delicensing parts of the sites to release land for development.

Main Responsibilities

To support this programme we are enlarging an existing team to manage the procurement and production of safety documentation for all facilities, projects and other activities, necessary to satisfy project and Regulatory requirements. Vacancies exist for experienced safety case professionals to produce and manage the planning and production of safety case documentation. Positions are available for Safety Case Project Managers and Engineers, depending on skills and experience.

Safety Case Engineers are responsible for producing, and supporting the production of, safety case documentation for facilities, decommissioning and engineering projects. Safety Case Project Managers, in addition, are responsible for managing the production of safety case documentation for operational facilities and decommissioning projects, for programme management, for developing and advising on standards and methods, co-ordinating safety case engineering support and managing staff, contractors and the overall safety case budget.

Aptitudes and Experience

The positions will be based either at Harwell or at Winfrith. In either case there will be the requirement for regular travel between the two sites. Applicants will be qualified to degree level in an engineering or science discipline or have qualifications leading to membership of an appropriate professional body. Good interpersonal, communication and negotiation skills are required.

Significant recent and relevant experience of producing modern standards safety cases is an essential pre-requisite for both roles. Two years such experience is required for the Engineer post and five years such experience is sought for the Project Manager post.

Safety Case Project Managers will, in addition, have broad experience in the management and delivery of modern standards safety cases to programme, quality and budget.

Both positions require a sound knowledge of current safety regulations, particularly in relation to the Nuclear Site Licence.
